- 1. A minimum of 40semester credits are to be completed prior to admission to the Human Services Program.
- 2. A minimum cumulaive grade point average of 2. @Orequired in all courses completed.
- 3. All applicants must conhete the General Educatio Category Requirements at Montana State Univers Byllings, or at another regionally accredited institution of higher education, earning in min grade point average of 2.00. Courses taken on a pass/no pass or credit/noncredit basis will not be accepted to fulfill thine nearnts. Students should consult with their academic advisor.
- 4. A minimum grade of B in HS 345.
- 5. The application should be accompanied by a background checkworkling copy of the student's transcript. The application should be submitted to the faculty advisor for review and approval and signed by the advisor
- 6. No internship can be completed without prior acceptance to the HS or REHA programs.

Students not accepted are encouraged to apply for admission during the next application tipes the responsibility of each student to ensure that a completed application is submitted by the deadline. It is suggested that applications be submitted at least three (3) weeks prior to the end of the semester during which application is not the Rehabilitation Programs denied, the applicant may appeal the decision to the Rehabilitation & Human Services Committee of the Department. The Department Chair serves as chair of the appeals committee.
