


C. Process Clarification for Selection of Specific Courses in Categories I-V:

<p><u>Concern 1:</u> In contrast to the existing General Education Requirements, the proposed Academic Foundations program reduces the overall number of approved courses.</p>	<p><u>Goal:</u> Limit the overall menu to approximately 30-40 courses across all categories (I-V).</p>	<p><u>Committee Guideline:</u> Approve 6-8 courses per category (I-V).</p>
<p><u>Concern 2:</u> Encourage College-level planning and coordination, especially as a means of streamlining the selection of specific course for the specific categories.</p>	<p><u>Goal:</u> Allow Colleges to submit a package of courses for considerations.</p>	<p><u>Committee Guideline:</u> Accept from each college no more than 10 courses per category (I-V).</p>
