## II. DISCUSSION/ACTION ITEMS

## A. ETS as a Graduation Regirement

The Committee has discussed on numerous occasions that the ETS Proficiency Profile test won't give us good data unless all our students are taking it. In the past the Committee has been told it is not feasible to make the ETS test a graduation requirement, but we have now come to the point where it is necessary. We need a meaningful way to assess our Gen Ed program, and the ETS test will be a part of it. If we want to get something going this year, we need to take action at today's meeting, as we should never shy away from telling the administration this is the right thing to do.

It was noted that the cost may be high to test every student. Vice Provost Redinger noted that funding from the Assessment Fee is sufficient to cover the costs.

- Motion by Patty Nichols, seconded by Tom Regele that the GEC recommends to the Academic Senate that the ETS test be made a graduation requirement for year programs and implement as soon as possible
