II. DISCUSSION/ACTION ITEMS

A. Course Mapping/Alignment

Committee members reported on what they learned from colleagues regarding mapping couthe two Respect Diversity program outcomes.

Political Science and Sociology are appropriately mapped, and are very amenable to submitting assessment materials.

Music conveyed they are good with MUSI 101, but MUSI 147 does not achieve either two outcomes and should be removed.

Biology stated they should remove all of the BIOB courses from both outcomes.

There was no response on the BGEN course (which is shared between COB and City College).

History is on board and ready to gather assessment materials.

The Psychology course had interesting responses: one instructor says yes, the outcoachieved, while another instructor said no, they are not achieved.

The Anthropology courseported to fit the outcomes.

The Art courses meet both outcomes and there will be artifacts for submission.

B. Revision of Gen Ed Program Learning Outcome #9
