Lonnie Schrag, Team Leader of Nursing, Health, and Safety Occupations, stated that the medical community has requested a certificate in medical coding because there is a shortage in this area. Most doctor's offices don't know that this specialty, which includes medical billing and insurance, exists. The new certificate program includes four new courses, and will also utilize several existing courses. Jane Hansen will be the .5 FTE director. This certificate may also feed into the medical assistant program, which currently has relatively low enrollments. Those students who complete the certificate and the AAS in medical assisting will be able to handle both sides of a doctor's office—the clinical responsibilities as well as coding and billing. The beginning semester of the certificate is similar but not the same as the health occupations core. This project is funded by a two year sustainability grant.
