Susan Gilbertz, Environmental Ses Program, stated that this program hasbeen reviewed for a few years, so the faculty of this interdisciplinary program gathered and made several changes. They took advantage of the free credits from the smaller Gen Ed package and added a second writing course. Students in the past were required to take one environmental policy course, but employers are very interested in this part of the degree, so it has been strengthened as a section with several courses to choose from. There is a courseworks on planning and regional development, but it is not ready yet. The program is still 120 credits.
